1. Monday, January 1 – New Year’s Day
2. Monday, January 15 – Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
3. Monday, February 19 – Presidents’ Day
4. Monday, May 27 – Memorial Day
5. Thursday, July 4 – Independence Day
6. Monday, September 2 – Labor Day
7. Thursday, November 28 – Thanksgiving Day
8. Friday, November 29 – Day After Thanksgiving
9. Wednesday, December 25 – Christmas Day
10. Diversity or Religious Holiday
 - June 19 = Juneteenth (Wednesday)
 - June 26 = LGBTQ+ Equality Day (Wednesday)
 - Oct. 14 = Indigenous Peoples’ Day/Columbus Day
 - Any religious holiday, provided EOs take it for religious observance

There are many holidays that celebrate diversity and employees may choose to celebrate one of the days listed above or a religious holiday.

Holiday pay is what the full-time and part-time employees who work at least 20 hours per week would have earned if they had worked on the day observed as a holiday. Temporary employees and employees on unpaid leaves of absence do not receive holiday pay.

YPI may need to schedule work on an observed holiday due to the needs of the business. If you are required to work on a holiday, you may take a day off later, subject to your supervisor’s prior approval.
